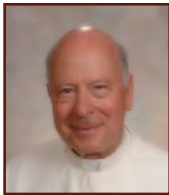

## Sacrament of Mercy Conference Speakers



### Rev. Alfred McBride, O.Praem.

Father McBride is a Norbertine and a member of St. Norbert Abbey in De Pere, Wisconsin. Ordained to the priesthood in 1953, Father McBride has served as a high school teacher, novice master, professor at Catholic University, president of the University of Albuquerque and spiritual director for Aid to the

Church in Need, USA. The U.S. Catholic bishops appointed him to write the catechesis in preparation for the second pastoral visit of Pope John Paul II to the United States in 1987 and also to be a special representative to the media during that visit. He has lectured widely and written many books and articles. He served as a consultant on the Catechism for the Archdiocese of Boston and was a professor of Homiletics at Pope John XXIII Seminary. He has also done various series for TV programs on the Acts of the Apostles, the Apocalypse, Blessed John XXIII and Images of Mary for EWTN. He lives at St. Joseph Priory where he continues his writing ministry, retreats, workshops and helping in parishes.



### The Very Rev. Canon Matthew R. Mauriello

Ordained to the Priesthood on January 11 in the Marian Year 1988. Presently, he is the pastor of St. Roch Church in Greenwich, Connecticut in the Diocese of Bridgeport. Serves on the Board of Directors of several Catholic International Organizations. USA President for the World Apostolic Congress on Mercy held in

Rome in April 2008 and the North American Congress on Mercy, held in Washington, DC in November 2009. A member of the International Executive Committee and currently working on the planning of the Second World Apostolic Congress on Mercy to be held in Krakow, Poland in October 2011.



### Father Andrew Apostoli, CFR

Ordained a priest by Bishop Fulton J. Sheen in 1967. Member of the Community of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal which he was instrumental in helping to found in 1988 in NY. Active in teaching, preaching retreats and parish missions, and in giving spiritual direction throughout the country. He is an adjunct faculty

member of Saint Joseph's Seminary in Dunwoodie, Yonkers, New York. Currently, serves as Vice-Postulator for the Cause of the Canonization for Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen.

Father Andrew has been active over the years producing different TV series for EWTN and giving talks on various spiritual topics, many of which are available on DVD's, CD's, and tapes. He has written various books and pamphlets on the spiritual life.



### Dr. Bryan Thatcher

Bryan and his wife Susan founded the Eucharistic Apostles of Divine Mercy (EADM) – a lay outreach ministry of the Congregation of Marians of the Immaculate Conception – in 1996. EADM members receive spiritual formation in small faith-sharing groups called cenacles. There are now over 2,000 cenacles in 24

countries. The apostolate also promotes Eucharistic Adoration and praying the Divine Mercy chaplet for the sick and dying. A prominent and national speaker on Divine Mercy, Bryan also co-authored Rachel Weep No More, with Fr. Frank Pavone. Bryan was a speaker at the recent North American Congress on Mercy in Nov 2009 held at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington D.C.



### Rev. Robert Finn Bishop of Kansas City-St. Joseph

Ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of St. Louis on July 7, 1979. Prior editor of The St. Louis Review. for the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Named a Chaplain to His Holiness in August 2003. Ordination to the episcopacy in 2004. Currently, the sixth bishop of the

Diocese of Kansas City ~ St. Joseph. Work for the USCCB includes consultant to the Pro-Life Secretariat and past Chairman of the Bishop's Task Force on the Life and Dignity of the Human Person. Member of the Board of Directors for Catholic Athletes for Christ, and other Catholic national organizations. Member of the Knights of Columbus, the Equestrian Order of Knights of the Holy Sepulcher, and a Knight of St. Peter Claver.



### Rev. Father Clement J. Machado, S.O.L.T.

Born in British Columbia, Canada and raised in Montreal, Canada. Member of SOLT, the Society of Our Lady of The Most Holy Trinity. Early priesthood included ministry in Canada and in the Southwestern United States, and was former Vice-Rector of his community's seminarians in Rome, Italy. Involved with Vatican

Radio and has presented a series of television and radio programs on EWTN on Padre Pio and other spiritual topics. International dynamic preacher on a comprehensive range of topics. Ministry focuses on intercessory prayer, sacramentals and especially the sacraments, particularly the Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation. Father Machado pursues his international evangelization ministry on five continents through preaching, teaching, retreats, parish missions, conferences, days of recollection and Bible study. He is currently based in Rome, Italy.



### Rev. Paul Keller, OP

Ordained a priest on May 21, 1993 in Washington D.C. Acquired Bachelor and Licentiate in Sacred Theology at the Pontifical Faculty of the Immaculate Conception in Washington D.C. and a Doctorate in Rome in 2007. Presently, the Assistant Professor of Sacrament of Theology at Mt. St. Mary's of the West Seminary in Cincinnati

and Adjunct Professor of Theology at Steubenville Franciscan University. Presents numerous lectures, conferences and seminars on a far ranging array of subjects including the sacrament of Reconciliation, the Holy Mass, Liturgical Worship, spiritual conferences on the Rosary throughout the country including the Pontifical North American College in Rome. Guest appearances on various subjects on Relevant Radio, the Catholic Channel on Sirius Radio including Vatican Radio. Experience includes Vicar of the Master of the Order of Preachers and sub-prior of St. Dominic Priory in Ohio. Current President of The Society for Catholic Liturgy. References include the Most Rev. Augustine DiNola, OP Secretary for the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome.
